Access: The Theatre fulfills its commitment to make its world-class productions accessible to people of all income levels through subscriptions and a variety of discount and low-cost ticketing outlets. The Theatre began offering open-captioned performances for those who are Deaf and Hard of Hearing in the 2021-2022 Season.

Humanities: The Theatre promotes learning at all ages by inviting general audiences to engage with the language and ideas of the Theatre's productions through its free Humanities Programs, which operate under the guidance of its Council of Scholars, four distinguished academics with expertise in a variety of humanities disciplines.

In the 2021-2022 Season, the Theatre's Humanities Programs engaged approximately 670 people through nine free "TFANA Talks" - post-show discussions with the productions' casts, creative teams, and eminent scholars and community members. In addition, for each mainstage production, the Theatre's free, online dramaturgical publication - the 360° Viewfinder - offers context on the plays' themes and interviews with the creative teams. The three 360° Viewfinders for the 2021-2022 Season received a total of 4,679 impressions and were read online 765 times.

The Theatre also partnered with Saint Flashlight to present The Will of the City, a poetry installation based on the work of William Shakespeare, displayed on the streetside and outdoor screens at Polonsky Shakespeare Center. TFANA also partnered with CLASSIX to launch the first chapter of (re)clamation, a new podcast uplifting and re-centering Black writers and storytellers of the American theatre. The first series of five episodes was commissioned by TFANA as part of the CLASSIX-TFANA Residency and released in July and August 2022.
